Dear parents of H.S.A.P. students,

As a student enrolled in the High School Apprenticeship Program, your son or daughter will have a number of responsibilities that must be fulfilled in order to earn credits. These responsibilities include:

- 1. Strong attendance at work. They are responsible for getting to work.
- 2. Strong attendance at school. Poor attendance at school and poor marks can lead to a loss of their H.S.A.P. placement.
- 3. Good communication with their employer, especially when they cannot attend work due to illness, etc.
- 4. Strong performance at work. They are going to be treated like a regular employee and if they are not satisfying the requirements of their employer they can be laid off. If that occurs, they will only receive credits for marks of 70% or higher on their evaluation.
- 5. Hand in their pay stubs to me monthly so that I can keep track of the hours they have worked. Remember
 - No hours No credits!
- 6. Complete all of the required paper work. We won't keep track of hours until all of the paper work is handed in.
