



## Report to the Community June 2026

We would like to extend a thank you to our entire school community for an amazing school year. This school year saw us celebrating many successes both academically and athletically. We had two Envirothon teams this year advance to Provincials. One team won Regionals and the other finished 2<sup>nd</sup>. At Provincials the teams finished 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> with one team finishing 1<sup>st</sup> in the oral competition. Two WCI students finished in the top 10 at the Caring for Watersheds Competition. On our WCI's Male Hockey Team one student was selected as the WSHL Sportsmanship Award winner and the Travis Price Memorial Scholarship recipient. The JV Girls Volleyball team finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at Provincials. The Varsity Girls Volleyball team won the Provincial Championship for the first time since 2019. The JV Boys Basketball team were Provincial Finalists and reached the final for the first time since 2009. The JV Girls Basketball team finished 4<sup>th</sup> at Provincials. The Varsity Girls Basketball team hosted AA Provincials and finished 4<sup>th</sup>. Students were very successful at Track and Field Zones with many personal bests. Warren Collegiate won the Track and Field JVG Zone 5 banner, the Varsity Girls Zone 5 banner and Most of our teams were able to capture Zone 5 banners in their respective sports. Thank you to all our staff and community coaches for the hours and hours of time they dedicated to our students at Warren Collegiate. We are continuing along with support from the Community and beyond to the Upgrade our Track Project. We are underway with phase 3. Through many initiatives we would like to say thank you for all the support.

We continuing working on the Interlake School Division's Continuous Improvement Plan which saw our school set goals and carry out these goals throughout the school year. As we continue to work on the ISD Continuous Improvement Plan, we will also continue to focus on numeracy, literacy and wellbeing along with student connection to learning. Our Focus Areas in order to provide High-Quality Learning Opportunities include

**#1: Accessible** - if every learner can and will learn, in their own ways, in their own time.

**#2: Equitable** - if every learner is valued and authentically represented in their education.

We will continue to move forward with running mathematics all year long at the grade 9 level to bolster the foundation of mathematics to foster a deeper understanding. With Grade 11 and 12 Pre-Calculus we plan to provide time and a half instruction to help students develop better understanding in higher level mathematics. With Literacy we will continue to help students build confidence and willingness to engage with language in order to acquire, construct and communicate meaning in all aspects of daily living.

We continued to build on our plan from last year, by running several Wellness Weeks throughout the school year where staff and students participated in a variety of activities. An activity that went very well again this year was “The Hunger Games”. Our plan will be to continue with school wide activities to build school community. As a school and staff we continue to integrate Indigenous Perspectives into our classroom instruction and activities through providing different exposure through activity days and through inviting Elders to come and share their knowledge with us. A huge thank you to our staff and students who are apart of the Leadership Team for all they do to help build a great school culture here at Warren Collegiate. We were able to have our grade 8 transition afternoon, with a barbecue and a scavenger hunt in the middle of June again this year. This afternoon is designed to alleviate some anxieties leading up to the start of high school for our new grade 9 class. We are so excited with the upcoming school year for 2026-2027.
